At Pacifica, we offer nature-based field trips. Field trip schedules are customizable. We can accommodate up to three classes together for a field trip experience. Spend the day rotating between stations that will include science, art, and lots of fun.

Activities range and vary between:

- Learn about plants at ForestFarm Nursery
- Study aquatic ecosystems at Williams Creek or Friendship Pond
- Art Nature Trail
